## *“Open Call for Entries”*

The **Cork Architectural Association** wish to invite Cork based architects to submit a project for our annual architecture exhibition. The 2017 exhibition which is titled *“L’Architecture Quotidienne”* will be hosted in the foyer of the Cork City Civic Offices from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> of October to Friday 1<sup>st</sup> of December. The selected projects will feature in a special review in the Irish Examiner as well as an exhibition booklet.

The aims of the association are:

- a) To advance public education and promote interest in architecture and other creative arts particularly among the people of Cork city and County.
- b) To create a challenging and innovative programme of exhibitions to educate and stimulate debate about contemporary architecture and its place in society.
- c) To provide affordable architect led gallery space in Cork city for architecture exhibitions and other creative arts events for emerging and established architects and other creative people.
- d) To establish a support network through which architects and other creative people can meet and exchange ideas, skills, knowledge and information.

## **Cork Annual Architecture Exhibition**

### *Theme*

The theme of this year’s Cork Annual Architecture Exhibition is *“L’Architecture Quotidienne”*. Cork Studios/Architects are invited to submit projects which have been completed in the last five years that tackle and engage with the theme of *“L’Architecture Quotidienne”*. The jury will be looking for projects, domestic or public, that successfully deal with this theme. Each studio may only enter one project.

## Entry Process

### *Submission Stage 1*

1. 150 word (Maximum) description of the project
2. 4-5 high quality project images in JPEG format at 300dpi
3. Key Plans and Sections in JPEG format with a scale bar at 300dpi
3. Images to be titled and include architect/practice's name in the file name (*Architect/Studio name not to be written on the photo to preserve anonymity of the entrant*).
4. Contact information for architect/practice

Entrants may submit one project only.

## Adjudication

Adjudication by the jury will take place in early September. Successful applicants whose project are to feature in the exhibition will be invited to submit further information on their project for the exhibition. The decision of the jury is final. The results of the jury's selection will be issued to all entrants shortly after the adjudication.

## Submission Stage 2

The selected entrants will be invited to submit one A1 Sheet in portrait format to document their project for the exhibition. The board should include the following project information:

1. *Project Name + Architect's Name*
2. *Project Location*
3. *Project Description*
4. *Site Area in m<sup>2</sup>, Project Area in m<sup>2</sup>*
5. *Key Plans and Sections with scale bar and north point*
6. *Key Interior and Exterior images*

Format: A1 Sheet in portrait format to be foam mounted (No framed submissions)

Digital Submission on CD: *A1 Board in PDF Format, High Res Images at 300Dpi in JPEG Format, PDF Drawings at 600dpi in JPEG Format.*
